



Surgical Hubs – essential in reducing waiting lists

With the promised £1.5bn funding, surgical hubs aim to pool resources to deliver increased elective activity within a health system or geography – to bring down the backlogs. But these hubs can be made far more productive with accurate, consolidated waiting list data that avoids DNAs and enables clinicians to treat all patients in clinical priority and date order.

Elective Care Hubs are being hailed as the first step in reducing the huge waiting list backlogs, with each region or Trust looking at the best way to establish them across their geography. London, for example, is looking to

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fast track the creation of centralised surgical hubs within each of its five ICS health systems to cover the high-volume specialties – orthopaedics, ophthalmology, urology, gynaecology, ENT and general surgery. Whereas regional trusts are looking to combine existing resources for high throughput centres that optimise clinical staff, bed capacity, use of diagnostic equipment and theatre space, to maximise patient flow.

Collaborative approach to shared care crucial

Managing and coordinating elective activity with other trusts will necessitate a collaborative approach, and system-wide, integrated processes. The need to schedule patients into the hub, book resources, carry out treatments and ensure follow up care without adversely effecting existing care pathways throughout the rest of the trust is critical. One northern trust outlined the need for an IT infrastructure that enabled – a visibility of true capacity, an accurate understanding of waiting lists, patient prioritisation at system level – against

wait times and clinical priority, detailed collaboration between trusts, and a data and analytics capability that understands the demand for each speciality. Plus, the clinical leadership to ensure standardisation and prioritisation across the region.

Core need for accurate, up-to-date, accessible data

What is absolutely clear is that each location will have its own specific challenges, but the underlying need is for accurate, up-to-date and accessible data on which to make both strategic and operational decisions in a continually evolving landscape. Manual, out of date spreadsheets are no longer fit for purpose.

Core to any responsive demand and capacity planning and elective backlog reduction is an accurate, consolidated data foundation on which to base pivotal decisions.
